# All-Star Team Criteria – Women & Senior Women

## Purpose

To recognize bowlers in the GPUSBC who have demonstrated superior performance in the sport of bowling in local, GPUSBC sponsored leagues and tournaments.

## Eligibility

All GPUSBC bowlers that have bowled in a certified league at a center within the jurisdiction of the GPUSBC are eligible, provided they are in good standing with the association. Points will be awarded from June 1 to May 31 in GPUSBC leagues and tournaments hosted by the GPUSC.

• Anyone age 55 or above prior to June 1 will automatically earn points towards the senior All-Star team. If the bowler wishes to earn points for the women's All-Star team, they must let the GPUSBC Association Manager know in writing prior to June 30.

#### Leagues

Points awarded based on highest average in any one center. League must start after June 1 and end prior to May 31 to receive the average points. Bowlers must bowl at least 48 games in the league for the average to be valid for use.

• Bowlers will be awarded one point per pin using their highest average in the GPUSBC.

### **City Tournament**

Points are awarded in the scratch all-events category ONLY. The top 15 women and top 15 senior women will earn points (see note below):

#### Scratch All Events

- 1<sup>st</sup> 15 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> 14 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> 13 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> 12 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> 11 points
- Etc. until 15<sup>th</sup> 1 point

\*Women may compete in the Open Tournament or Women's Tournament. If the bowler competes in multiple tournaments, ONLY the first 9-game set bowled will be considered. At the conclusion of the tournament, all women's all-events scores, regardless of tournament, will be pulled, compared, and points will be awarded accordingly.

\*Senior women may compete in the Open Tournament, Women's Tournament, or Senior Open Tournament. If the bowler competes in multiple tournaments, ONLY the first 9-game set bowled will be considered. At the conclusion of the tournament, all senior women's all-events scores, regardless of tournament, will be pulled, compared, and points will be awarded accordingly.

### **Honor Scores**

ONLY honor scores achieved in GPUSBC sponsored leagues and events will be awarded points. See point structure below:

- 290 299 games
  - o All games between 290 and 299 will receive 1 point
- 300 game
  - 1<sup>st</sup> 300 of the season 2 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> 300 of the season 4 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> 300 of the season 6 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> 300 of the season 8 points
  - $\circ$  5<sup>th</sup> 300 of the season 10 points and so on
- 700 799 series (add 5 pts. to scheduled points below if series is 800+)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> 700 series 3 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 series 6 points
  - $\circ$  3<sup>rd</sup> 700 series 9 points
  - $\circ$  4<sup>th</sup> 700 series 12 points
  - $\circ$  5<sup>th</sup> 700 series 15 points and so on

#### **Senior Queens**

Points are awarded based on scratch qualifying scores prior to match play (only those being considered for the Senior Women's All-Star team may qualify for points through this event):

- 1<sup>st</sup> 15 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> 14 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> 13 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> 12 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> 11 points
- Etc. until 15<sup>th</sup> 1 point

\*\*If another tournament awarding All-Star Team Points is added during the season, bowlers will be notified via social media.

\*\*All-Star Team qualifications are to be re-evaluated as needed at the end of each league season.
