THE HALLENE O. WALLS STUDENT BOWLER OF THE YEAR AWARD annually recognizes a male and a female GPUSBC youth bowler who is currently in high school. These award recipients stand out for their distinguished certified bowling performances, academic achievement and extra-curricular activities. The award winners will receive a \$500 scholarship. This scholarship will be formally presented at the annual GPUSBC Hall of Fame & Awards Banquet. In the case of all male or all female applicants only one scholarship will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be a current GPUSBC Youth member in good standing
- 2. Currently in high school (Freshman through Senior)
- 3. Have a current GPA of 2.5 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
- 4. Completed application
- 5. Include at least two letters of reference (by a school official, employer, bowling coach, etc.)
- 6. Include an official or unofficial school transcript
- **7.** Return all completed documentation and application to the Great Plains USBC Association office post-marked no later than **MAY 1ST**. (Incomplete applications will not be accepted)
